How to get there:

### By bus:

For the Oakham Hopper local bus timetable click <u>here</u>
Use Route Three and dismount behind the Rutland County College For bus services to/from other areas, click <u>here</u>

# By train:

On foot: Leave the station by the exit to Platform 2, turn right along Barleythorpe Road to the first junction, bear right into Lands' End Way. The volunteer Centre is about 200 metres on the left-hand side. The entrance to the car park is just after the Volunteer Centre .

# By car:

Free parking on site, including spaces for people with disabilities.
